**#1 Kayaking Black Canyon / Hoover Dam Price: \$189+\$13\* Net: \$153**

Minimum – 2 persons Maximum – 40 persons Available Year Round \*\$13 NPS launch permit required

This section of the Colorado is moving flat-water, it is not a whitewater trip. It is perfect for first timers as well as seasoned paddlers. Starts at Hoover Dam with a stop at a hot spring. All Day.

**#2 Kayaking Lake Mead Price: \$149 Net: \$121**

Minimum – 4 persons Maximum – 45 persons Available Year Round

Introductory kayak trip that is slower paced. Approximately 3 hours of paddling on a large lake. Water conditions are mostly flat, but can be choppy depending on wind, and weather. Roughly 3 miles round-trip. Enjoy instruction on basic paddling techniques swimming and a picnic lunch on an island beach.

**#3 Hiking / Hot Springs Price: \$129 Net: \$105**

Minimum – 4 persons Maximum – 20 persons Available Sept. thru April

Trail is roughly 6 miles roundtrip. Downhill hike in, uphill hike out through a narrow canyon with 800 foot walls. Most of the trail is a smooth gravel wash, with some minor rock scrambling in order to reach the hot springs. Hot spring temps range from 96F to 120F degrees. Technically it is an easy trail, but physically it's rated moderately strenuous. You will definitely get your heart pumping on the hike out.

**#4 Mountain Biking Price: \$129 Net: \$105**

Minimum – 2 persons Maximum – 25 persons Available except July & August

River Mountain Trail (Beginner) Scenic path wide enough for hikers, bikers, and horses alike. 90% of the trail is downhill, with spectacular views of Lake Mead. Trail is both paved and smooth dirt surface. Perfect for beginners, families, and all ages. A fun, easy ride with a lot of history and a tour of Hoover Dam.

Bootleg Canyon (Intermediate/Advanced) Over 35 miles of singletrack with both cross country and downhill trails. Trail is rough dirt surface with rocks, bumps, and obstacles. The newest official bike park in the West, Bootleg Canyon also boasts a terrain park for advanced riders. Must be 14 and older.

**#5 Scenic Biking & Hoover Dam Tour Price: \$149 Net: \$121**

Minimum – 2 persons Maximum – 25 persons Available except July & August

Above biking trip with hoover dam tour.

**#6 Downward Delight (Hike/Kayak) Price: \$199 Net: \$161**

Minimum – 6 persons Maximum – 20 persons Available September thru May

Combine a 3 mile hike through a narrow canyon with 8 miles of kayaking to make the perfect adventure in the desert. Hike, soak in natural hot springs, and enjoy paddling the Colorado river in your own kayak.

**#7 Surf & Turf (Kayak/Bike) Price: \$199 Net: \$161**

Minimum – 6 persons Maximum – 25 persons Available except July & August

Above bike trips combined with a lake paddle.

**#8 Southwest Canyon Escape (3 days) Price: \$499 Net: \$401**

Minimum – 6 persons Available May thru October

Three day tour of Bryce, Zion, and the Grand Canyon. Each day is spent touring a different park where you will have the opportunity to take photographs, sightsee and hike in these amazing natural areas. Walk along the rim of the Grand Canyon, splash down the Narrows in Zion and hike through the colorful Bryce Canyon. This tour is the ideal way to experience the natural wonders of America's Southwest.
